[Use of smartphones and tablets in the galleries for web browsing and equivalent photographing]

From April 4 to June 2, 2024, on a trial basis, visitors to the Museum and Library will be able to use their own smartphones or tablet devices to browse the web and take photos in the galleries. After evaluating the impact of this trial period, we will consider how to proceed. The Hōsa Bunko Library galleries do not currently have Wi-Fi facilities, but internet access is available, so use of smartphones and tablets is permitted.

When searching for information or taking photographs in the galleries during this trial period, please observe the rules and manners described below, and follow the instructions of the staff.

TRIAL PERIOD: April 4 (Thu.) – June 2 (Sun.)

RULES TO BE OBSERVED

[PHOTOGRAPHING]

- Since this trial period is intended to allow visitors to search for information and photograph items on display for their convenience, the use of equipment devised for the sole purpose of taking images (single-lens reflex cameras, digital cameras, etc.) is not permitted this time.
- For the artworks indicated by 🖉 marks, web browsing and photography are prohibited.
- Use of equipment that may endanger the protection/safety of the artworks, such as flash photography, tripods, and selfie sticks, are prohibited.
- Please refrain from photographing for long periods of time, videoing or taking commemorative/group photos in the galleries.
- When taking photos, please be careful to not take photos of other visitors.
- Please refrain from taking consecutive or continuous shots, as the sound of the shutter will interfere with other visitors' viewing.
- Depending on the conditions in the galleries, the museum may prohibit the use of smartphones and tablets during this trial period.

[USE OF PHOTOGRAPHED IMAGES]

- Images taken are to be for personal use only. They may not be used for commercial purposes. Individual permission is required for media and other publication purposes.
- Posting on blogs, social networking sites, etc. is the responsibility of the users. The Museum will not be held responsible for any problems with third parties in this regard.
